BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY & POOL:	

REGARDING THE SITE & FACILITIES:

1. Homeowner is responsible for all water testing, and for all procedures needed to prevent the spread of recreational waterborne illnesses (RWI's).
2. Homeowner is responsible for the proper functioning of the pool and all safety equipment.
3. Homeowner has placed safety rescue equipment – such as a reaching pole, rescue tube, or buoy, in plain site and easily accessible.
4. On the day of the lesson, homeowner will confirm that all safety equipment is in place, and that the water quality is safe for swimming.
5. Homeowner has ensured that all chemicals are stored properly and secured.
6. Homeowner confirms that pool meets all federal, state and local codes.
7. Diving boards, slides or any other similar equipment will not be used during instruction.
8. Homeowner understands that strict enforcement of Red Cross recommended diving restrictions and progressive teaching protocols will be followed. The depth and design of the pool will determine if diving is allowed. If diving is not safe, diving will not be allowed.
9. Homeowner agrees to have a restroom facility available for instructor.
10. Homeowner understands that inclement weather and/or lightening will require immediate and safe exit from the pool and deck areas. Instructor will make every attempt to exit the property, however if necessary homeowner should allow the instructor a safe place to shelter.
11. Homeowner should review their site-specific emergency action plans (EAP) with the instructor.
12. Homeowner confirms that a phone landline is accessible and working; or that a charged and working cell phone is available.
13. Homeowner agrees that no pets or other swimmers will be allowed in the pool during class.
14. Teaching equipment brought on site by the instructor is the instructor's property, and will be clearly labeled as such. If any equipment is borrowed or left behind, it should be returned to the instructor. Includes items such as floatation noodles, diving toys, and balls.
15. Homeowner understands that it's advisable to have a first aid kit accessible during lessons. Commonly stocked items include plastic adhesive bandages, gauze, waterproof adhesive tape, safety scissors, tweezers, ice packs, rubber gloves and absorbent paper towels.
16. Homeowner understands the parameters of their homeowner's liability insurance.
17. If the student is 17 years or younger, their guardian understands and has signed the Waiver/Liability agreement provided by LifeCycle Aquatics, LLC / Jennifer May.
18. Homeowner, or assigned guardian, agrees to be on site and on deck, with a clear view of any minor student during all lessons at all times.
19. Homeowner or guardian is never to leave any minor student alone with the instructor at any time.
20. If the client is an adult, eighteen years or older, no guardian supervision is required.
21. The homeowner and LifeCycle Aquatics, LLC dually acknowledge the contagious nature of the Coronavirus/COVID-19, and that the CDC and many other public official and doctors still recommend practicing social distancing.
22. The homeowner and LifeCycle Aquatics, LLC dually agree to not use the pool if they are sick or have symptoms described by the CDC, or have been exposed to or diagnosed with Coronavirus/COVID-19.
23. LifeCycle Aquatics, LLC and Homeowner each voluntarily seek this agreement, and agree that we are increasing our risk to exposure to the Coronavirus/COVID-19. We each agree to comply with all recommended CDC procedures to reduce the spread while using the pool and surrounding deck areas.
